The book scholarship is administered by VCMAAC, a non-profit, student-aid alumni association. Every complete application received by the required deadline will be given a fair and careful evaluation. Awards are given without regard to race, color, creed, religion, sex, disability, or national origin. All information will be held in confidence by the VCMAAC. All applications become property of VCMAAC and cannot be returned.

**Carefully review your completed application before it is submitted.** The VCMAAC reserves the right to process only those applications found to be complete by the application postmark deadlines. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SUBMITTING ALL REQUIRED INFORMATION IN ONE COMPLETE PACKAGE.** Guidelines and application follow:

#### **Guidelines & Application**

The VCMAAC Book Scholarship was created to assist students from Atlanta, Ga with the high cost of textbooks, and study material. Awards are open to current students at Voorhees College. Up to 4 awards are made annually. Students may reapply each Semester.

#### **Application Process**

Applicants must send

- A completed application and resume
- An unofficial or official transcript of grades
- A \$5 application fee (check or money order)

Applications must be received by the following schedule:

Fall: Application must be postmarked by July 15<sup>th</sup>

Spring: Application due by December 15<sup>th</sup>

#### **Selection Process & Notification**

Scholarship recipients are selected according to merit on a competitive basis. In addition, applicants must demonstrate career and academic potential. The number of scholarships awarded will be based on the VCMAAC selection procedure and available funds. Not all applicants will receive awards. Although the committee would love to inform all applicants of their status, unfortunately this is not feasible. Only scholarship finalists will be contacted by the selection committee.

#### **Award & Payment**

The VCMAAC stipend is a one-time award amount of \$250 each semester. Awards may be used in any year, and non-renewable. Awards are paid in one installment, that will be mailed to the students' home address at least 2 weeks prior to upcoming semester. Checks are payable to recipient.

#### **Revision Policy**

The general conditions and procedures under which scholarships are made are subject to periodic review by VCMAAC, including termination of book scholarship.
